Porsche GT3RS

Packing a 520hp naturally aspirated 4.0 litre Flat 6 (that revs to 9000 RPM) mated to the incredible PDK Transmission, the GT3RS a track day dream.

The optional Weissach package drops 38 pounds off the car's weight thanks to magnesium rims and carbon-fibre bits and pieces.

The rear wing is full Race Spec and all business, generating a mind-bending 1100 pounds of downforce at its top speed of 312km/h.

Porsche GT2RS

The Iconic Porsche 911 in the GT2RS specification is an absolute track monster...

Porsche hit it out of the park when they built this car.

With its Twin Turbo 3.8 litre flat 6 power unit generating 700hp, 553 lb-ft of torque, getting to 0-100km/h is achieved in just over 2.5 seconds!

Porsche 918 Spyder

The Porsche 918 is a Hyper Car... and it's a plug-in hybrid!

With a combined 887 hp and 944 lb-ft of torque from its mid-mounted V-8 and electric motors—one at each axle—the 918 Spyder delivers Bugatti-like acceleration, tenacious handling, and a 340km/h top end. And of course, it's every bit as exotic-looking as any million-dollar supercar should be, with a low-slung, targa body, and ultra-futuristic cabin.

Lamborghini Aventador S

I drafted a few different descriptions in an attempt to accurately capture this next piece of Automotive Art. I deleted them all...

At its core, it's as simple as this. It's a Lamborghini... Almost everyone who was into cars when they were younger, had a Lamborghini Countach poster on their bedroom wall (right next to Cheryl Tiegs or Scott Baio). The Lamborghini Brand is the Grand Daddy of all super cars. At the heart of this Aventador S is a naturally aspirated 6.5 litre V-12 engine that revs to 8500 RPM. It produces an exhaust note that is nothing short of intoxicating.

McLaren 720s

With its dihedral doors, twin turbo V8 and active aerodynamics, the 720s is a track day weapon.

Fast specs: 710hp, 568 lb-ft of torque, 7 speed DCT, carbon fibre tub, a dash that physically motorizes and moves into a different layout when the car is put into track mode, 0-100km/hr in 2.9 seconds, 341 km/hr top speed.

This thing is a proper race car with license plates!

The McLaren 720s is equally at home having its photo taken, tearing up a race track or cruising down the road.

Ferrari F355

This is a prime example of an analog sports car.

This Ferrari's beauty is not in its technical gadgets and creature comforts... the beauty is in the pure driving experience.

The Ferrari F355 Berlinetta is powered by a naturally aspirated V8 with a manual 6 speed transmission.

Ferrari 488 Pista

This car has an incredibly unique spec. The exterior is finished in Viola Hong Kong with Giallo Triplo Strato stripes.

Part of Ferrari's Tailor Made program, this exquisite piece of automotive art is truly bespoke and built to the clients every specification.

Ferrari F12

It's a Ferrari....It's Red.....It has a V12, what more could you ask for?

Powered by a 6.3L V12 with 730HP, propelled by a seven speed dual clutch transmission, The F12 has a top speed of 340km/h.

The exhaust sound is all Ferrari!

Alfa Romeo 4C

Alfa Romeo's baby supercar comes equipped with a carbon fibre chassis and carbon composite body panels. With less than 400 examples in Canada and most of those being the spider model, this coupe is a rare sight. Power is provided via a bespoke 1.7L turbo 4 race engine mated to a 6 speed dual clutch transmission. And with a curb weight around 2300lbs this modern Italian go kart is one of the purest driving experiences available today.

Lotus Evora 400

One of several examples brought into Canada. This rare toy comes with a high revving 3.5L Toyota sourced supercharged V6 producing 400hp that sounds like a mini F1 car at redline. With legendary Lotus driving dynamics this corner carving machine needs to be taken to the track to unleash its true potential.

Mercedes AMG GTS

The GT uses a front mid-engine, rear-wheel drive layout, with the engine positioned inside of the vehicle's wheelbase. The spaceframe chassis and body are made out of aluminium alloys. The suspension system is a double wishbone unit at the front and rear, with forged aluminium wishbones and hub carriers.

The car is powered by a 4.0-litre M178 twin-turbocharged V8 engine. The engine is a "hot inside V" configuration—with exhaust manifolds and turbochargers inside the cylinder banks to reduce turbo lag—and uses dry-sump lubrication.

Power is sent to the rear wheels through a seven-speed AMG SPEEDSHIFT dual-clutch transmission.

The AMG GTS is a hand built masterpiece. This car is equally at home on a country road drive or on the race track.

Mercedes AMG C43

The C43 AMG excels as daily driver, a road trip car and a track day weapon!

Powered by a 3.0 litre twin turbo V6, this car is a rocket ship. The interior is all Mercedes quality from top to bottom, bespoke and built to the clients every specification.

With only 8000 original miles, this particular example of America's V10 sports car, is a pristine example of an era of cars that will soon be behind us. Until that time...hammer down!

Plymouth Prowler

The Plymouth Prowler is a perfect weekend cruising car.

This car is none too fast, but when you look this good... people will wait.

This car has been in my collection for over 20 years, this one is on the never sell list.

Dodge Challenger Scat Pack with The Shaker Package

A blend of old school muscle car and high tech wizardry, this naturally aspirated 6.4 litre V8 Hemi produces a monumental 485 HP and 475 lb-ft of tire shredding torque.

This particular example is finished in "Sublime" Green.

Brembo 4 piston calipers ensure you'll be able to stop when decelerating from its top speed of 327km/h!

Indian Scout Bobber

1300cc's of music to your ears being played through upgraded Vance and Hines exhaust pipes. This thing is 100% Bad Ass.

The owner of this machine says that once out on the open road, all of life's troubles fade into the background, if only for a spell...

I don't doubt that for a minute.

Camaro ZL1

Chevrolet went to the drawing board to make an extremely track capable Camaro... they succeeded.

With a supercharged 650hp power unit and a manual transmission, the ZL1 is a track day sweetheart. And if your race suit gets wet, you can hang it over the massive downforce generating rear wing to dry!





Mustang Shelby GT500 “Eleanor”

Unless you’ve been living under a rock since, well, before you were born, you should know what this car is. It’s Eleanor, or rather, a replica Eleanor, built from an officially licensed Shelby GT500. It might seem self-evidently badass. Make no mistake, the car so perfectly embodies the essence of badass that the people behind it — from Classic Recreations — might as well have a masters degree in the field. But its righteousness is far beyond skin deep.



Mustang Shelby GT500

As the most powerful and quickest factory Mustang ever produced, the Ford Mustang Shelby GT500 blends modern sports-car performance with iconic muscle-car presence.

The GT500 makes speed effortlessly with equal parts brains and brawn, including a supercharged V-8 that hammers out 760 horsepower, and a quick-shifting seven-speed dual-clutch transmission.

With track-developed aero, suspension and wheel technology. Massive 16.5-inch two-piece SHW rotors, six-piston fixed Brembo front calipers and advanced chassis tuning are standard.

A Carbon Fiber Track Package adds carbon-fibre wheels, GT4 track wing and custom Michelin Pilot Sport Cup 2 tires.

Corvette C1 "Vivacious"

Vivacious sits on a Roadstershop Chassis and is powered by an 800 hp Pro Charged LT.

This car just won the 2020 Toronto Motorama Grand Champion and Good Guys Top 10 Builders Choice along with being nominated for the "Best On RS" at 2019 Sema Show in Las Vegas.

Ford Mustang GT350R

The sound that the GT350R makes is truly otherworldly thanks to its high revving flat plane crank V8.

Corvette C6 Z06

The 6th Generation Corvette Z06 is equipped with the LS7 Power Unit. It is the largest displacement small block ever produced (427 cubic inches). Pair that engine with a manual transmission and you have a combination that leads to many smiles.

Corvette C7

The Corvette has long been known as America's Sports Car. This is one of the best road trip cars in existence. But don't let it's mild street manners fool you... the C7 is equally at home on a race track.

Corvette C8

This is NOT GM's first rodeo with a rear or mid engine car (Fiero and Corvair). However I can tell you from experience that this time GM got it right!

The C8 Corvette is powered by a 6.2L V8 with an 8 speed Dual Clutch Transmission.



Dodge Viper ACR

The Dodge Viper is America's V10 sports car. This is the machine that contends with the European cars on the track.

Equipped with its Extreme Aero Package, the Viper effectively becomes an upside-down airplane wing, and as the speedometer climbs, the bodywork levers itself ever harder toward the pavement. At the ACR's top speed, 285km/h, the Viper generates 1,710 pounds of downforce.
